### Application Requirements

- Applications must be accompanied by at least two letters of recommendation from faculty on college letterhead and sealed in an envelope. Recommendations should address your personal and academic attributes that are predictive of success in your career.
- Include an essay of approximately 200 words that describes your background and professional aspirations to support hearing impaired individuals. Include any volunteer or personal experiences that support your professional goals.
- Obtain your most recent official transcript in sealed envelope.
